## **Competitor Insurance –**

As a club we have a responsibility to ensure that all our members have adequate insurance to compete at our events, for the peace of mind of all competitors and organisers. Currently the Club runs its events under British Carriagedriving rules and as such we have noted that in BDS Keyfacts their insurance cover does not cover it's members at any of our events apart from the Summer Show.

British Carriagedriving Associate Membership (or Young Membership for under 21's) Can drive at Club events, National Novice Qualifiers (including those at National events) and Regional Events. Can groom at National events. Has full legal liability insurance at home and at events, 365 days a year. Receives British Carriagedriving Yearbook and newsletters, can vote and attend British Carriagedriving A.G.M. and Conference.

If you have private insurance which covers competition you can compete with us but we require a copy of this insurance with your entry or your entry will be returned.

## Back/Body protectors -

As of January 2015 back/ body protectors have become compulsory for both drivers and back steppers at National and Regional level competitions, as of January 2016 they will be compulsory at Club level too. They are not required for dressage and cones or showing classes. If you are a member of NWDC you can take your membership card to Eskdale Saddlery at Longtown and get 10% off body protectors.
